

INVESTMENTS IN LARGE-SCALE COMMERCIAL & INDUSTRIAL PROJECTS CONTINUE IN THE JANESVILLE-BELOIT MSA



A pair of industrial projects, and one significant commercial development, are featured in this quarter's Project Profile section. Combined, these projects represent nearly 400,000 SF; account for more than \$65 Million in capital investment; and are projected to generate hundreds of new jobs.

NaturPak Pet - which represents a new venture for natural food manufacturer and co-packer of Janesville-based IPM Foods - will design, manufacture, package and distribute high-quality, natural wet pet food products from their new 162,000 SF in Janesville's STH 11 Business Park.

The company has targeted mid-2019 as its initial operations date. To facilitate this development, the City of Janesville provided a Tax Increment Financing package.

Beloit welcomed Seal-Rite Door into its manufacturing community, as the company announced that it was expanding and relocating its custom residential entry door design and manufacturing services to Beloit's Stateline Industrial Park. Seal-Rite is leasing a 105,000 SF building that was originally launched as a speculative building by Hendricks Commercial Properties. Initial production is expected to begin by mid-2019. To facilitate this project,

Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC) provided an income tax credit package.

Beloit's momentum during the quarter continued with the announcement that ABC Supply Company will be expanding its corporate headquarters. A new 4-story, 132.000 SF office building will be constructed on the company's Riverside Drive campus to accommodate its administrative, accounting, credit and finance related functions. By early-to-mid 2020, this facility will be operational and eventually have the capacity to accommodate staffing levels in the 500+ range.
